Academy Conversion

The school's full governing body met recently and voted unanimously to register an interest with the Department for Education for Northwold to convert into an academy. The registering of interest does not in any way bind us at this point into becoming an academy. Over the next two months we will be holding a consultation with staff, parents / carers and pupils to hear your views and answer any questions you may have. All parents are invited to a consultation meeting with The Governing Body on Wednesday, 23rd October at 6.30pm. If you require an interpreter, please let the staff in the school office know before Tuesday morning.

Once that process is completed the governing body will meet again and take a formal decision about whether to proceed to become an academy.

Year 5 Residential to Kench Hill

Medical Appointments

Routine medical appointments to see the doctor, optician or dentist must be made either after school, or in the holidays. If it is an emergency appointment, or if it is for an appointment with a consultant at the hospital, time off will be agreed. Please provide the school with a copy of the appointment letter, or appointment card to allow us to authorise the request.

Free School Meals

Did you know that the school gets additional money for every pupil who is registered for free school meals? It really helps the school community so it is very important that every child who is entitled is registered. The parents of pupils who are free school meals can still decide whether they want their child to have school dinners or packed lunches. The government uses the numbers of pupils registered for free school meals to set targets, compare achievement data and to set the budget.

You can apply for free school meals if you receive one the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-based Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and your income is £16,190 or less (this figure changes each April).
- Working Tax Credit for four weeks after your employment finishes
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Support from the National Asylum Support Service (NASS)*

* Asylum seekers need to provide their IND Letter or IND Card, social services letter or their NASS letter in order to qualify for free school meals.

Please come to the school office and pick up the form, once filled in bring it back to us with your proofs and we will forward it to Hackney Learning Trust

Privacy Notice - Data Protection Act 1998

We Northwold Primary School are the Data Controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act. We collect information from you and may receive information about you from your previous school and the Learning Records Service. We hold this personal data and use it to:

- Support your teaching and learning;
- Monitor and report on your progress;

- Provide appropriate pastoral care, and
- Assess how well your school is doing.

This information includes your contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information ¹ and personal characteristics such as your ethnic group, special educational needs and any relevant medical information. If you are enrolling for post 14 qualifications we will be provided with your unique learner number by the Learning Records Service and may also obtain from them details of any learning or qualifications you have undertaken.

We will not give information about you to anyone outside the school without your consent unless the law and our rules allow us to.

We are required by law to pass some of your information to London Borough of Hackney (Local Authority), formerly The Learning Trust, and the Department for Education (DfE)

(For Academy use only) We are required by law to pass some information about you to the Department for Education (DfE) and, in turn, this will be available for the use(s) of the Local Authority.

In addition for Secondary Schools

Once you are aged 13 or over, we are required by law to pass on certain information to the provider of youth support services in your area. This is the local authority support service for young people aged 13 to 19 in England. We must provide the address of you and your parents (and your date of birth) and any further information relevant to the support services' role.

However, until you are aged 16 or older, your parent(s) can ask that no information beyond your name, address and date of birth (and their name and address) be passed on to the youth services provider. This right transfers to you on your 16th birthday. Please inform (Insert name of School Administrator) if this is what you or your parents wish.
