Video Games

We have noticed an increase in the number of children who are playing video games designed for adults. If a child plays a game designed for 12, 15 or 18 year olds then it will be viewed as child abuse. Parents have a responsibility to protect their child by ensuring that they are not exposed to violent and sexual images. If you allow your child to play these games then you are neglecting your responsibilities as a parent. The games have serious effects on children and it will manifest itself in the way in which they play and communicate with other people. There have been some very distressing reports in the news of children involved in very violent crimes because of the video games they were playing at home. If the school knows that children are playing inappropriate games then we have a duty of care to refer our concerns to Social Services.
