Free School Meals – Free Check

If you think your child might be eligible for Free School Meals, there is a free way to check this online. London Grid for Learning (LGfL) have created a website (link below), where you put in your child's details and find out if they are entitled to Free School Meals. If they are, this will also entitle the school to additional government funding (called the Pupil Premium), which the school can invest in more staff and resources to improve our students' education.

Please click on the link to see if your child is entitled to Free School Meals - www.fsm.lgfl.net. If your child is entitled, the school will be informed directly as well. As a 'thank you' to parents for making a check, and as an incentive to participate (even if they believe their child would not be eligible), LGfL is making available free of charge the Sophos Anti-Virus software provided to LGfL-connected schools, to protect computers at home used by pupils.
