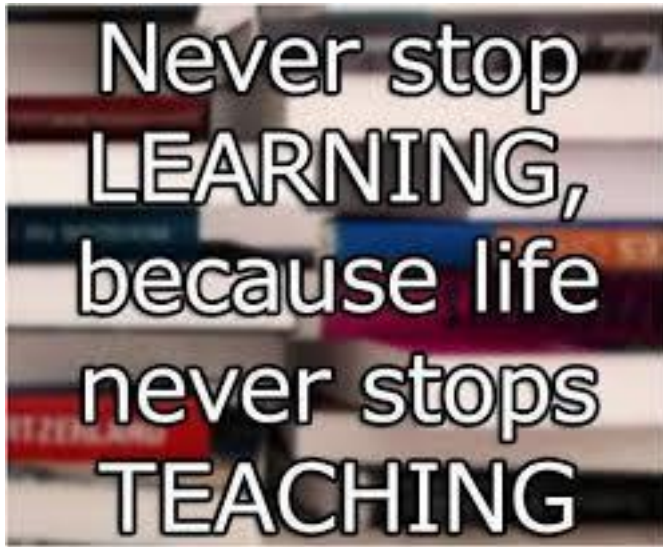

scheme called the Minor Ailments Scheme, which aims to help those who can't afford to pay for certain medicines or those who can't access their GP easily. If your child is unwell and the GP surgery is closed, you can go to the pharmacist and have a consultation. If necessary, the pharmacist can prescribe medicine for your child. If they can't treat your child, they will refer you back to the GP or to A&E. The type of ailments they can treat may include coughs, colds, headaches, hay fever, insect bites and stings, eczema, earache and diarrhoea. You can choose the language in which you receive information in the settings page, and you can filter information that's not relevant to you in the categories page (under settings).

SMART rules – 'A' stands for Accepting



In the third of our series about e-Safety, we are continuing to talk about the SMART rules of internet use. 'A' stands for Accepting. If you **accept** emails or messages or open files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust, this could lead to problems – there could be nasty messages or viruses. This can be difficult when messages pop up on screen frequently, so be prepared to watch what your child is doing and help them to deal with these sorts of problems in a sensible way.
