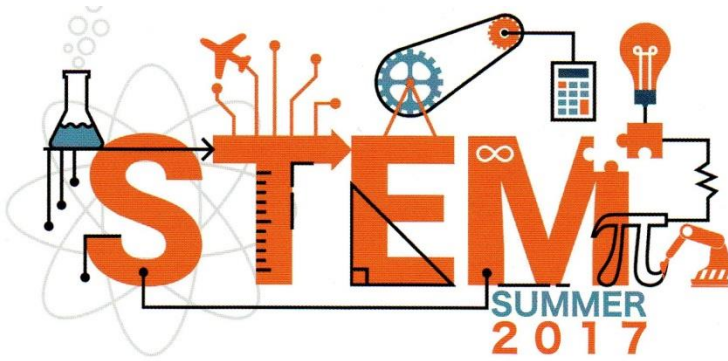

### Plus so much more...

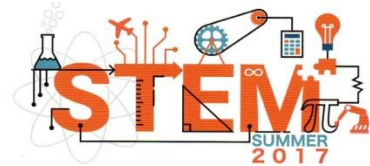

## King's Cross Walks and Activities

Take the 73 bus down to King's Cross and there are five fantastic things you and your family can do:

### 1. Kings Cross Station

Compare and contrast what we saw at St Pancras station with its neighbour. Look at the amazing architecture of the new roof and spot the statue of Sir Nigel Gresley (who designed over 2,000 trains).

### 2. St Pancras Old Churchyard

Find the Hardy Tree and see how the building of the railways left scars on the London landscape.
