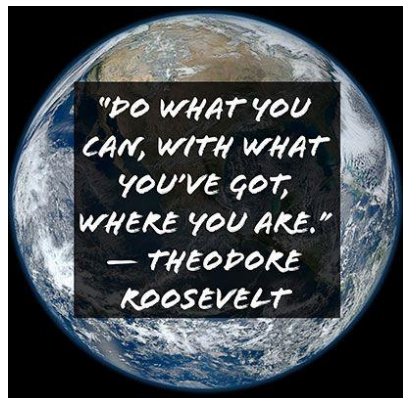

This year we would like to change the way we have our Parent Conferences. In light of feedback from staff re some challenges that they encounter in effectively facilitating these sessions-cancellation and rescheduling of meetings, non-attendance to meetings, we would like to have a Parent Afternoon/Evening Conference session once per term.

The date for this term is **29th November 2018** and parents would be able to sign up for their 10 minutes meeting slot with their child's class teacher. Once the sign up is completed, a Confirmation Letter will be sent to parents confirming the time of their meeting.

You will be asked to arrive 5 minutes early before your meeting with the teacher. Parents will be asked to sit and wait outside the classroom or nearest hall while looking through the books and waiting to go in and speak to the class teacher. We want to maintain the privacy that was given to parents during parent's conference morning by ensuring that only the parents meeting the teacher at the allocated times is in the classroom meeting with the teacher.

Forest School

All children from **Nursery to Year 2** will participate in Forest School. Forest School is an inspirational process that offers learners regular opportunities to achieve and develop confidence and self-esteem through hands-on learning experiences in a woodland or natural environment. On your child's Forest School day, your child will come to school in their school P.E kit (NOT SCHOOL UNIFORM) and wear it for the whole day.

Pupils will be provided with a light rain jacket to be worn over their coats; however you will need to purchase wellington boots. Also, as winter approaches and the weather gets wetter and colder, please ensure that your child is warmly wrapped up, wearing warm coats, hats, gloves and thermal socks.

Term Dates for 2018-19

The Education (School Day and School Year) Regulations (1999) require all maintained schools to open for teaching for 190 days a year, offering 380 sessions. The tables below set out dates for 195 days. Pupils are to be released for a further 5 days for the purpose of teachers' staff development (INSET). These days can be taken as inset days or equivalent twilight sessions

Academies, free schools and voluntary-aided schools are able to set their own dates but have been asked to set the same or similar dates in the interest of parents who may have children at different schools.

We have 3 INSET Days left for the academic year.
