### Parent Governor Vacancy

There is one vacancy on the governing body for Parent Governor. Any parent with a child on the register of this school (including the Nursery) may stand as a candidate by completing the nomination form and returning it to the school office. You may nominate 1 candidate or you may nominate yourself if you wish.

Governors play an important role in supporting the school and in making decisions about the service provided for your children. For example, they are responsible for:

- Helping to establish the aims and policies of the school and how the standards of education can be improved
- Helping to decide how to spend the school's budget
- The appointment, promotion, support and discipline of staff
- Drawing up an action plan after an OFSTED inspection and monitoring how it is put into action
- Helping to draw up the school's development plan
- Selecting the headteacher/deputy headteacher
- Linking the local community with the school

All these tasks are shared between members of the Governing Body.

It is essential that parents are fully represented on the governing body so we do ask you to consider this matter carefully. You do not need to be an "expert" in education and you will receive support from the other governors. Training is offered to help you understand your role and responsibilities but it is not compulsory.

The term of office for parent governors is 4 years but you may resign at any time, and you will be able to complete your term of office, if you wish, if your child leaves the school.

**Please come to the school office for a nomination form. The deadline for nominations is 4pm, Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2018.**

If we receive more than one nomination then it will be necessary to hold an election by ballot so that all of our parents can choose who will represent them on the governing body.

There are some circumstances that make people unable to be considered as school governors. These are shown on the nomination form.

## Forest School – Getting Ready for Winter

As autumn moves along and winter approaches, the weather is getting colder. As of today, when your child has their Forest School session, they must be dressed in correct Forest School clothing, which is: **black PE jogging bottoms, school PE top, school PE hoodie, a warm jacket, trainers or wellies, hat and gloves.** When it's very cold - **thermal long johns and a thermal undershirt under their PE kit** will keep them warm and happy at Forest School. The school will provide a rain jacket and water proof trousers. *(The school's waterproof trousers are showing their age no, so if you have waterproof trousers of your own for your child, please use them.*



## Anti-Bullying Week

It is Anti-Bullying Week from the 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> of November and this year's theme is 'Choose Respect'. Following a consultation with over 800 children, teachers and members of the Anti-Bullying Alliance, it emerged that a top priority was showing that bullying is a behaviour choice, and that children and young people can set a positive example by opting to respect each other at school, in their homes and communities, and online. We will be having daily class discussions around the issues.

- ✚ School red sweatshirt\*
- ✚ White polo top
- ✚ Black tracksuit bottoms – no logos
- ✚ Black trainers – no logos

On your child's P.E. day, your child will come to school in their P.E. kit (NOT SCHOOL UNIFORM) and wear it for the whole day. Your child needs to wear the school's P.E. kit:

- ✚ Black school hoodie\* (with your child's name in house colour)

- ✚ Plain black jogging bottoms (Leggings, jogging bottoms in other colours or with logos are not acceptable)
- ✚ Black plimsolls or trainers (no logos)

**Term Dates for 2018-19**

The Education (School Day and School Year) Regulations (1999) require all maintained schools to open for teaching for 190 days a year, offering 380 sessions. The tables below set out dates for 195 days. Pupils are to be released for a further 5 days for the purpose of teachers' staff development (INSET). These days can be taken as inset days or equivalent twilight sessions

Academies, free schools and voluntary-aided schools are able to set their own dates but have been asked to set the same or similar dates in the interest of parents who may have children at different schools.
