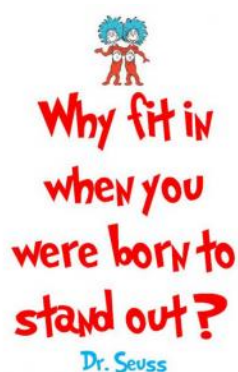

Brazil Class Year 4 Swimming Lessons

Brazil class have been really enjoying their swimming lessons at the King's Hall Leisure Centre.



Brazil class take swimming lessons every Wednesday and here are some of the comments from the children:

"Swimming is a type of sport that people play like in sport events. When we started to swim, some children were very good at swimming."

"The first time I went swimming it was scary. I told my partner I can't do it. I was trying when I got it only a bit. My best friend taught me how to kick my legs. She was really kind. I learned to put my face in the pool for three seconds."

"The best thing about swimming is jumping in the big pool in the deep end. It's so nice because you go all the way to the bottom and that's what I like about swimming."

"In swimming I enjoyed doing front care and back care. We did shout and signal which is basically if you fall off a canoe or anything that goes in the sea, you can wave both hands and shout 'help'. My favourite was when you jump."

"In swimming we started off in the small pool. We take the 106 to King's Hall Leisure Centre. After this, we get in the pool. We started off in the small pool. Then sir tells us we can have playtime. Finally, we get dressed then we get an orange or a cracker."

"The first day of swimming was exciting because we got to play in the big pool and our swimming teacher puts on our clip on floats and we have to jump in the deep pool. It is very fun."

"There are lots of stages in swimming. We are split into groups."

Forest School is an inspirational process that offers learners regular opportunities to achieve and develop confidence and self-esteem through hands-on learning experiences in a woodland or natural environment. Pupils will be provided with a light rain jacket to be worn over their coats; however you will need to purchase wellington boots. Term Dates for 2018-19

The Education (School Day and School Year) Regulations (1999) require all maintained schools to open for teaching for 190 days a year, offering 380 sessions. The tables below set out dates for 195 days. Pupils are to be released for a further 5 days for the purpose of teachers' staff development (INSET). These days can be taken as inset days or equivalent twilight sessions

Academies, free schools and voluntary-aided schools are able to set their own dates but have been asked to set the same or similar dates in the interest of parents who may have children at different schools.

We have 3 INSET Days left for the academic year.
