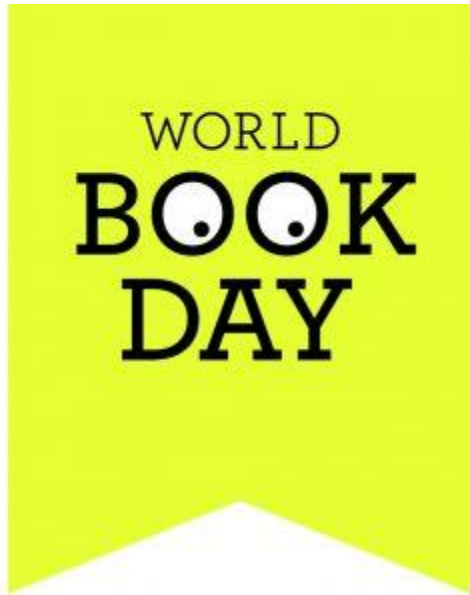
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## World Book Day

Our aim is to help more young people to see the future that they want – and make that future happen. We are one of three lucky units that have joined a nationwide trial to start our Junior Cadet detachment from the age of 9. We shall be holding an open evening for prospective new Juniors and their families on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> February from 18:00 – 20:00.

You are all invited to come and tour the unit, chat to volunteers and cadets and see some impressive displays, which aim to encourage more young people and volunteers to join the unit.

This is a great evening out for the whole family to experience first-hand what our Junior Sea Cadets get up to twice a week. It's also a fantastic opportunity to get to know other young people in the area and you'll make some great friends and learn new skills that will give you a great head start in life and will really boost your confidence.

Over the years, we have supported thousands of young people in the local area to learn nautical skills, with 22 cadets currently attending, supported by 8 volunteers. However, we are always on the lookout for more!

### Early Years

- ✚ School red sweatshirt\*
- ✚ White polo top
- ✚ Black tracksuit bottoms – no logos

## Term Dates for 2018-19

The Education (School Day and School Year) Regulations (1999) require all maintained schools to open for teaching for 190 days a year, offering 380 sessions. The tables below set out dates for 195 days. Pupils are to be released for a further 5 days for the purpose of teachers' staff development (INSET). These days can be taken as inset days or equivalent twilight sessions

Academies, free schools and voluntary-aided schools are able to set their own dates but have been asked to set the same or similar dates in the interest of parents who may have children at different schools.
